PERTSHIRE

Great opportunity to explore and hunt in the region's breathtaking variety, from its serene glens and endless expanses of lush forest, to its bleakly beautiful moors, rushing rivers and tumbling waterfalls. Perthshire's scenery is truly awe-inspiring.

We are located in Perth, only 45 min from Edinburgh and 60 min from Glasgow. Enticingly situated along the banks of the River Tay, Perth is Scotland's newest city and a sheer joy to explore on foot. Sandwiched between two sweeping public parks, this compact but buzzing cosmopolitan hub boasts many fine restaurants and cafés, outstanding venues and great shopping.

The region is famous for Roe Deer Stalking. With a large and well balanced Deer population, many hunters returning year after year for that special hunting experience.

HUNTING WITH US

You will be hunting on premium roe stalking grounds at Abercairny Estate, close to Perth and Crieff. The Estate ground is 3,000 acres of mixed woodlands and arable fields. Together with our partners we have access to another 30,000 acres in Perthshire.

Venator have deer management plans in place for all hunting grounds we lease and we also follow the UK Best Practise guidelines for deer stalking. We have some great Bucks on our grounds but we only harvest trophy heads as part of our cull plan to maintain a healthy mix of sex, age and deer population.

Before any stalking commences you will be asked to shoot 3 rounds at a target to make sure that your weapon is zeroed correctly and that you are capable of a satisfactory grouping. You will also be shown a health and safety brief before we start hunting.

We will pick you up from your local hotel and take you out to the estate ground. Stalking is mainly done by foot but we also have well placed high-seats available. You will be accompanied by a professional deer stalker at all times. He will guide you into a position so a safe shot can be taken. The stalking guide will gralloch the beast and transport the carcass back to the larder. We can arrange for the head to be cut, boiled and bleached.

The best time for Roe Buck stalking is from late April to beginning of June and from mid July to mid August (the rut). If you prefer Roe Doe stalking then November to February is the best period.

As a guideline, we recommend that you plan for 3 outings per beast when booking your hunt. We can accompany up to 4 rifles at any one time.

HOW TO GET HERE

If you are travelling from abroad the most convenient and nearest airport is Edinburgh airport, only 45 min from Perth. We can arrange pick up from the airport and take you to your hotel of choice. If you intend to do some sightseeing when you are here, a rented car might be the best option for you. Our hunting grounds are only 20 min from Perth and Crieff and we will pick you up from your hotel if you stay locally.

We are more than happy to arrange accommodation for you. Venator cooperates with some great hotels locally, catering for all requirements and wallets. If you bring your own gun some of the hotels have gun room/cabinets for safe storage, which is a legal requirement.

FIREARM PERMIT

Venator can help you with applying for a firearm permit if you want to bring your own gun. The application process takes min 8 weeks and you have to send us by post your European firearm pass (a colour copy will be acceptable) and fill in the application form on our web-site or by a PDF form which we can send to you. Venator takes no responsibility for delays in processing your application.

If you bring your own gun you need to bring all necessary documents/permits. Firearms must be of a legal and suitable caliber in Scotland (if in doubt, please contact us).

You will also need a valid shooting insurance, which covers UK. All documents must be presented to the stalking guide.

Venator can provide a suitable rifle to be used as part of your accompanied stalk at an additional cost.

WHAT TO BRING

The weather in Scotland can be unpredictable and for you to enjoy the stalking experience you should bring the following clothing and equipment:

- Waterproof clothing (camo or oak)
- Hat
- Suitable footwear
- Binoculars
- Knife
